	On April 9, 2003, the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) issued its conformity finding of the San Diego Region 2030 Regional Transportation Plan.

	On April 29, 2003, EPA published a notice in the Federal Register that finds the emissions budgets from the Ozone Maintenance Plan adequate for future conformity determinations. The determination is effective May 14, 2003.
